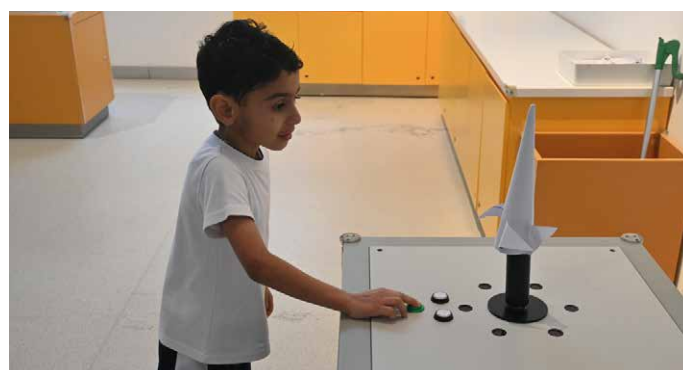

Sharjah Aquarium

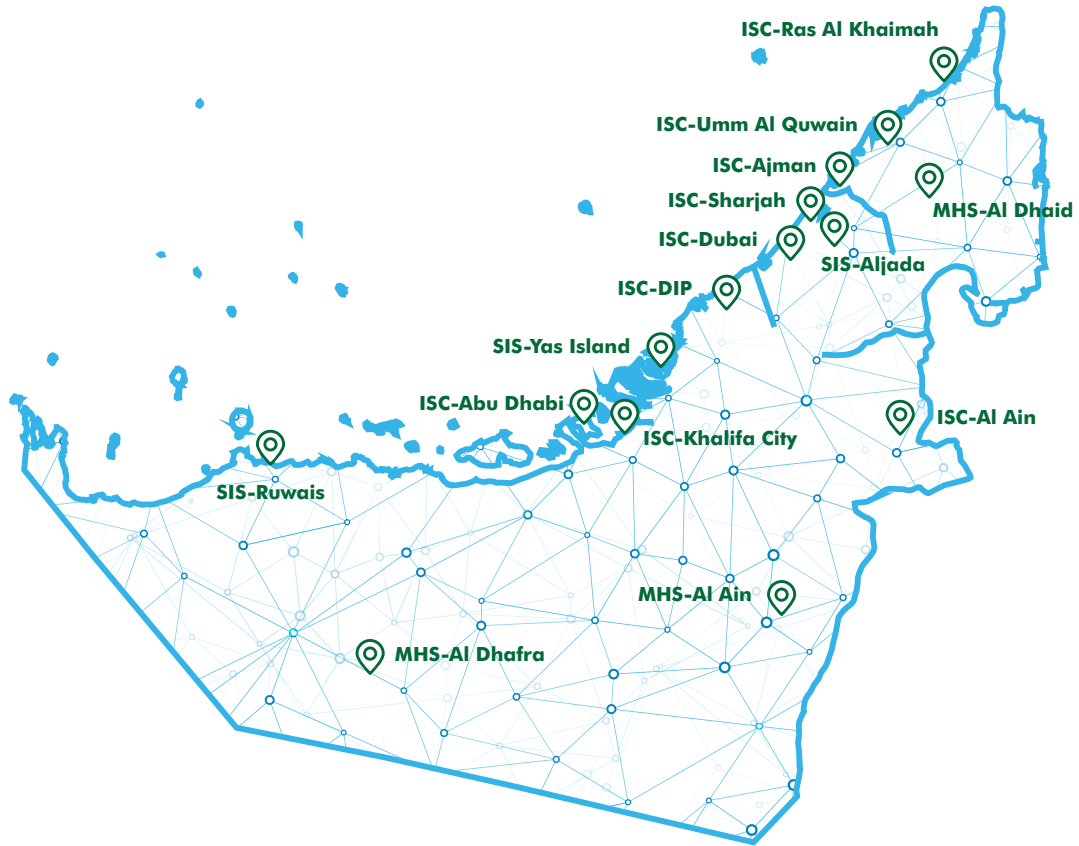
