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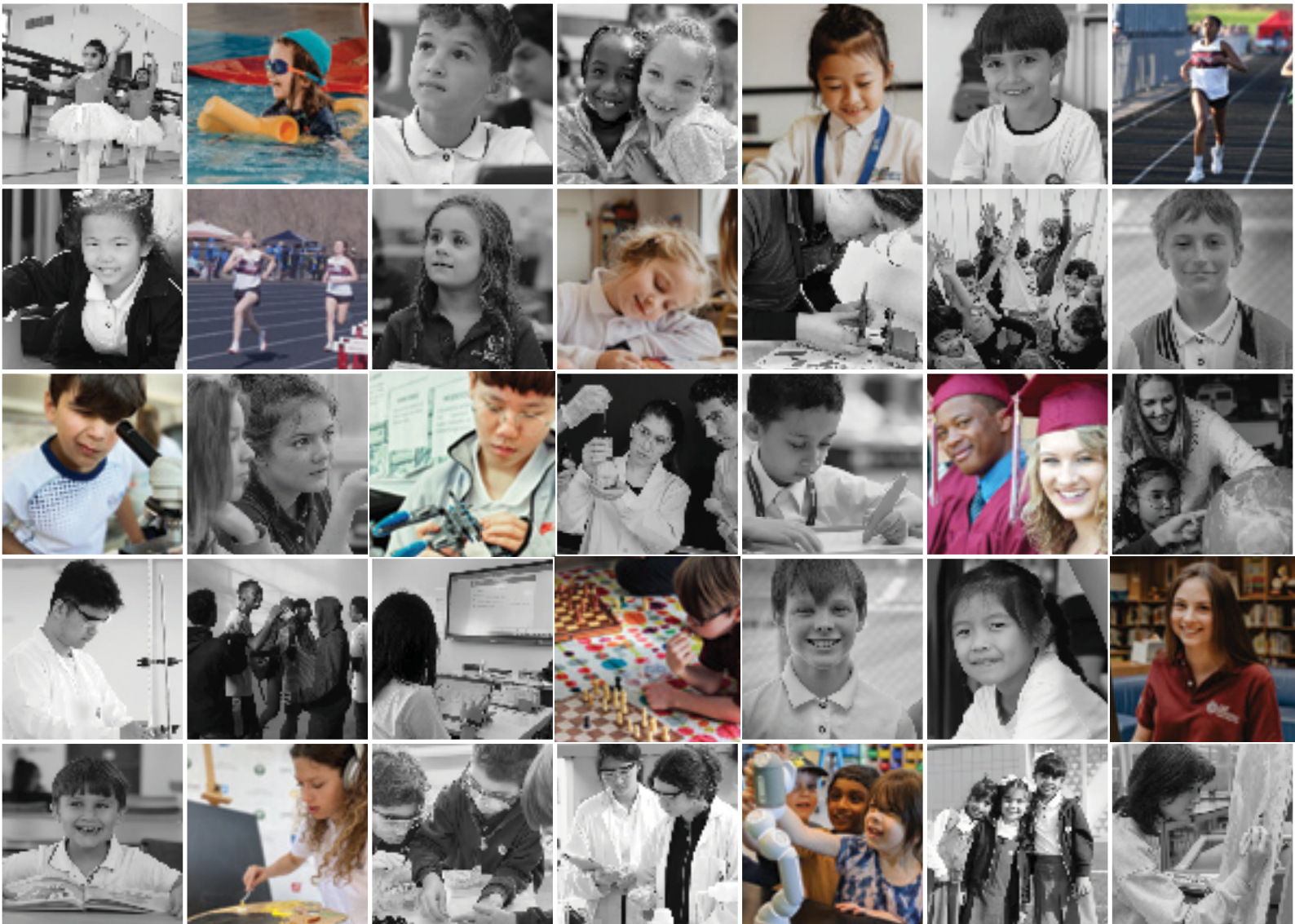


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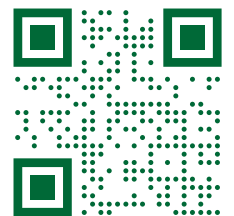

As we look forward to the next term, let us continue to work together to inspire and support our students in their learning journey.

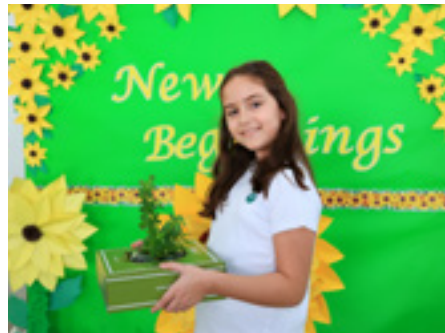

Welcoming Students into the AY 24-25

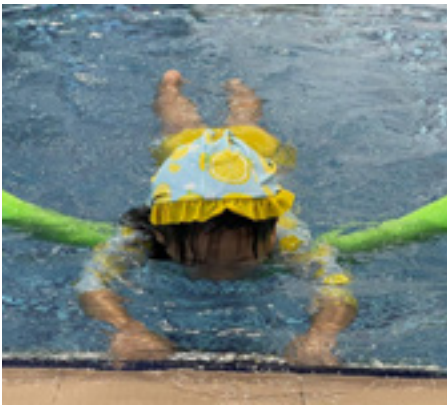

STEAM & SLO Clubs

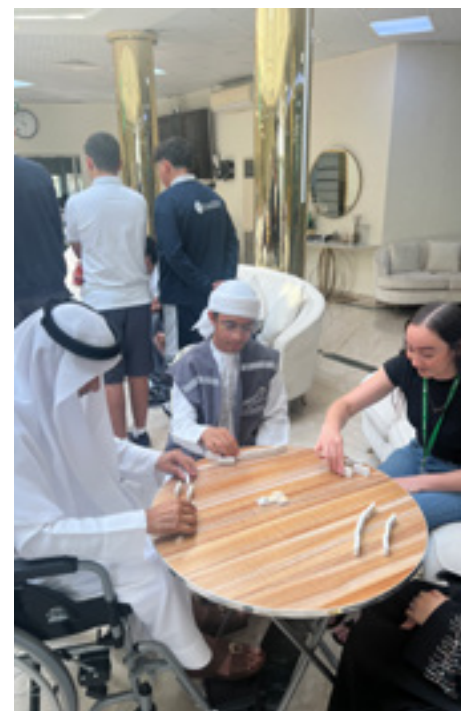
