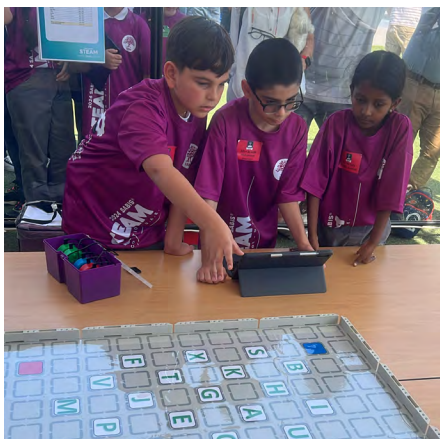
STEAM & ModelCOP

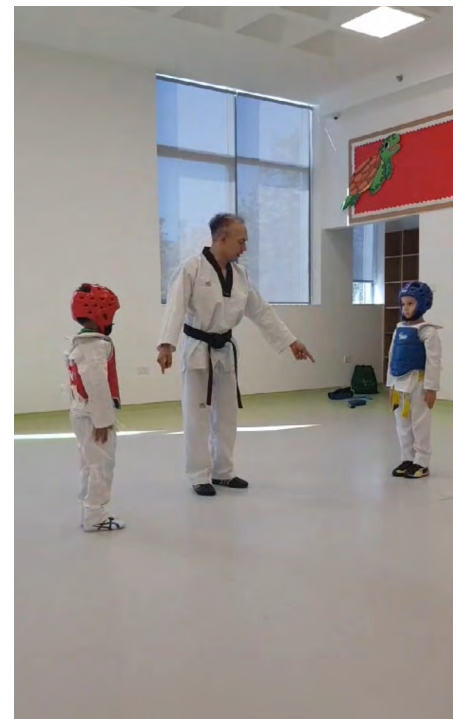
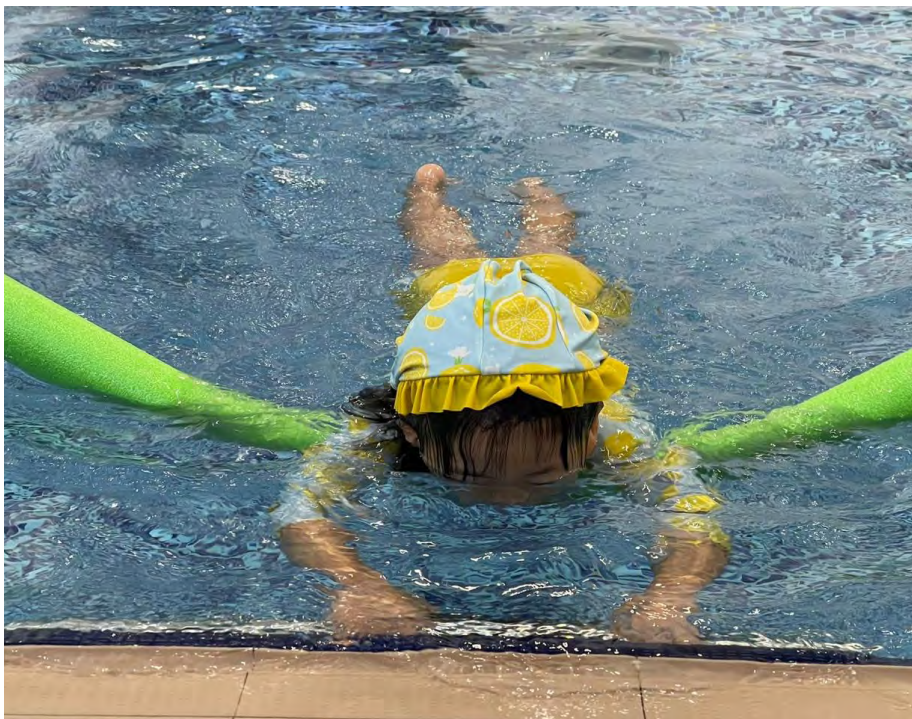
Extracurricular Activities
